

## GRAMMAR

### Remember!

We use **going to** when we talk about something that has already been planned or when something has already been decided.

### am/is/are + going to + verb

We also use **going to** when we can see that something is about to happen.

We can also use **going to** to predict the future if we have proof now.

1 Answer the questions using **am/are/is + going to + verb**. Answers will vary. Sample responses:

1. What are you going to wear to school?

**I am going to wear a shirt to school.**

2. What are you going to do this weekend?

**I am going to play outside this weekend.**

3. What is your mum going to cook tonight?

**My mum is going to cook spaghetti tonight.**

4. What time is your dad going to come home today?

**My dad is going to come home at six o'clock today.**

5. When are you going to see your friend?

**I am going to see my friend tomorrow.**

6. Where are you going to do your homework?

**I am going to do my homework at home.**


