The **Reading Eggspress Spelling** programme provides instruction on spelling rules, strategies and generalisations. Each lesson focuses on a core set of 20 words, plus 10 challenge words to extend students. The crafted word lists are based on the sound, structure and meaning of words, and they reflect the following statutory requirements of the *National Curriculum in England*:

Writing – transcription/Spelling

Pupils should be taught to:

- use further prefixes and suffixes and understand how to add them – as per DOE *English Appendix 1: Spelling*
- spell further homophones
- spell words that are often misspelt – as per DOE *English Appendix 1: Spelling*
- place the possessive apostrophe accurately in words with regular plurals [for example, girls', boys'] and in words with irregular plurals [for example, children's]
