History: The game was invented in 1891 in the USA, though it is similar to the game played in Mexico many centuries earlier. It quickly became very popular in America and later spread throughout the world. The international federation of Basketball was formed in 1932 and in 1936 the game became part of the Olympics.

The Game: Basketball is a very fast game for two teams of five players and five substitutes. The object is to score more points than the opposing team in the allotted time (two halves of 20 minutes each). The ball may be passed, thrown or rolled from one player to another. However, it may not be carried or kicked. Points are scored by throwing the ball into the basket—two points for a goal and one point for a goal from a free throw.

The court: the court is a rectangle on a hard surface (not grass). The standard size is 26m long and 14m wide. Free throw lines and lines to show the restricted area are also marked on the court.
